



Arizona Homicide Investigator's Association Basic Homicide Investigation Class

The Arizona Homicide investigator Association (AHIA) will be presenting its basic homicide investigators school for those interested in a career path toward being a homicide investigator/prosecutor. This class is open to all sworn peace officers, crimes scene investigators, county attorney prosecutors/investigators, and M.E investigators in the state of Arizona.

The school is a 40 hour block of instruction to be held **May 14th through the 18th, 2018 at the Mesa Police Training Facility; 3620 N. 40th Street, Mesa, Az. 85215** (202 Freeway and Greenfield Road). The class will run from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. We are attempting to obtain AZPOST Certification for most of the hours.

Some of the topics to be presented are crime scene management, drowning investigations, forensic art reconstruction, police involved shootings, police/arson investigations, blood spatter analysis, medical-legal death investigations, psychology of killing, and shooting reconstruction. There are other topics to be covered as well.

Our instructors are all subject matter experts in their areas, and will be presenting case studies in their presentations along with best practices.

In order to register for this class you must be a member of AHIA and you must register through AHIA's website; AZHIA.com. Hotel accommodations for those traveling from out of county will be up to the individuals to procure themselves, however The Hyatt Place or Sheraton Mesa are in the Mesa Riverview area and only 10 minutes from the training site.

The class is capped at 100 attendees so sign up early. The cost for the class is \$275 for current AHIA members.
